


THE 3 BRIDGES


EACH OF THE BRIDGES IS DIFFERENT, HAS IT'S UNIQUE FUNCTION AND CONSTRUCTION.


THE 3 BRIDGES ARE IN FACT 6 PONS WITH ROOM AND ITS OWN PROGRAM INBETWEEN.
















THE MUSEUM INTERIOR IS DEVIDED INTO TWO DIFFERENT MATERIAL LOOPS.




THE CRONBORG BRIDGE IN FACT CONSISTS OUT OF 3 BRIDGING ELEMENTS


THE ROOF OF THE KRONBORG BRIDGE ACTS AS A MAIN EXTERIOR CONNECTION
LEADING PEOPLE TOWARDS THE KRONBORG CASTLE




THE 2 BOTTOM PONS (THE AUDITORIUM BRIDGES) ARE SELF SUPPORTING EACH OTHER.




THE AUDITORIUM BRIDGE CONSISTS OUT OF SLOPE AND STEPPED BRIDGES





